Spathoglottis plicata

Species native to Southeast Asia. Pink flowers 3 cm. Up to 25 flowers open sequentially. Individual flowers last 5 to 7 days; the plant will bloom for 1 to 2 months depending on plant maturity. Flowers often self pollinate; seedpod will split in about 8 weeks and seed may be germinated on moist media.

Light: Moderate to high light.

Temperature: Warm growing.

Watering: Keep evenly moist but not wet; can occasionally dry out.

Fertilizing: Newly repotted plants should not be fertilized for 6 weeks, then fertilize with 20-20-20 at half strength, once a month.
